East Midlands Test Track

O Gauge

The East Midlands O Gauge Group's test track can accommodate most wheel standards, with the exception of ScaleSeven and some early, extremely coarse examples – there's not much that has defeated it – to 12v or 24v DC transmitted via 2-rail, centre 3rd-rail or stud contact (using the third rail as pick up) or live steam. Clearances between running lines permits running of 16mm/ft scale models running on 32mm track gauge.

L2 Lough Engine Shed 1950-65

O Gauge Finescale

Lough M.P.D. is a layout loosely based on the track plan of Slough W.R. Following on from my last layout 'Tolcarn,' I have again taken the track plan from E. Lyon's book *Great Western Engine Sheds 1947*. Owing to the Slough Shed being built on the inside of the Windsor Branch curve, I have straightened the plan out to fit my baseboards, hence being loosely based on Slough.

There are six baseboards, measuring $4 \times 27ft$, made of $3/\sin ply$ with 2×1 in framing, these stop the ply from flexing but make them heavy. Also, there is a seventh board for the traverser at $4 \times 3ft$.

Lough M.P.D. is a layout in 7mm fine scale with the old and well-tested method of DC Control. There are 120 sections operated by two Gaugemaster controllers. Each controller operates about half the layout, with some dual sections around the shed area.

The track is by Peco with the points and crossing by Markway. This is because there is a greater choice of points made by Markway and they custom made the crossing for me as one track is on a curve. They did this for me at very little extra cost.

The buildings are a combination of kits with the shed being built for me by Laira Models and the coal stage scratch build by myself.

The stock is from the 1950 to 1954 period that was seen on and around the Western Region; mainly steam, with some early diesels. Most are kit build with some RTR.



O Gauge Finescale

Chelagasa Town was conceived as a result of Heljan introducing a number of RTR diesels in O gauge and the need to have somewhere to run/show them. With a late 60s/early70s setting it is possible to run a mix of BR green/blue/maroon liveries along with pre and post TOPS numbering. When not being exhibited Chelagasa Town serves as the indoor terminus for an out and back O gauge garden railway.

The layout is loosely based around & WR/LMR setting and represents a small urban terminus with parcels siding and fuel point which also serves a nearby freight yard, hence there are quite a number of light engine moves to into and out of the fuelling point. Passenger services are mainly provided by DMUs although some locomotive hauled trains also feature.

Whilst no freight facilities are modelled the occasional freight train can be seen as it reverses before continuing on it's journey.

The layout uses DCC for locomotive control and all engines are equipped with sound for added realism.

Layout dimensions are 16 x 2ft excluding the Fiddle yard, total length with Fiddle Yard is 24ft.

L4 St Martin's Wharfe

O Gauge Finescale

A light railway inspired by the Colonel Stephens' railway empire. The line is somewhere in East Anglia, the terminus is beside a once navigable river and takes its name from the ruined abbey behind the station. The period is c1930.

The rolling stock follows Colonel Stephens' principles; there is nothing new, all second or third hand. The age of the stock is reflected in the finish of the vehicle.



Welcome to the south west Durham countryside circa 1928. Staindrop is a large village between Darlington and Barnard Castle, but never rail served. This 'might have been' branch is an attempt to model the old Central Division of the North Eastern Railway but in post grouping LNER days.

This allows for the first changes that were taking place under the LNER other than just the livery of the locos and coaches. The introduction of steam railcars to replace the NER autocars (push-pull) being an example. However, the pre grouping character of the branch remains with an infrastructure of pure NER.

The buildings and structures are all locally sourced. The station building is based on Battersby, the water tank from Middleton-in-Teesdale, and the wooden overbridge from the Stainmore line. Many of the details, such as fencing, are researched from original NER sources and drawings. The signal box, based on Bowes, and signals are mainly NER Central Division-not slotted and have simple caps rather than finials. The viaduct is based on an NER timber trestle from Ushaw Moor which lasted until the 1960s

The aim is to give representation of a country branch and the variety of facilities it might contain. There are coal cells, plus facilities for cattle, horses and milk, as well as passengers.

During your visit you may also be lucky to see the monthly stores train; or the annual inspection train; or even some snowploughs in the middle of summer!

The layout is mine but only possible with a lot of help from my friends at the Epsom & Ewell Model Railway Club.

L6 Arigna Town

O Gauge Finescale, Irish Broad Gauge

36.75mm fine scale Irish broad gauge. Based on Sligo, Leitrim & Northern Counties Railway. A proposed, but never built line to the coal mines near Arigna. Set in 1950s and runs with a mix of SLNCR and MGW stock - all scratch or kit built. Analogue powered, with LED lighting and a sliding and rotating fiddle yard. Has appeared in *Railway Modeller* and *BRM*.

L7 Thorne Hill Colliery

) Gauge Finescale

RAF Kinloss MRC

Thorne Hill Colliery is inspired by Thornhill Colliery near Dewsbury in West Yorkshire. The layout is set in the early 1950s prior to modernisation which greatly enhanced the colliery and its output. The buildings and structures (all scratch built) are as near to reality as possible with the exception of the pump house and beam engine which is a copy of a similar engine to Denby Grange, a little further down the valley. Some of the buildings include working parts and the layout has a number of little cameos depicting the workings in and around the colliery. You might even catch a glimpse of the friendly pit pony!

L8 Los Mochos

On 30 1/4 scale

The town of Los Mochos, high in the hills of New Mexico gives it's name to the railroad company that serves it.

"The Los Mochos & Southern RR", (LMS), is a main line railroad but the topography of the area meant a gauge of 30 inches was chosen to reach the town.

A busy depot serves the population for goods and transport, both for arrivals and departures. Local businesses make good use of the railroad with rail served connections.

Locomotive power is a mixed collection from many manufacturers, both steam and diesel power is in abundance. The superintendent has no problem with buying in used equipment as long as he can get a few years service out of them.

The layout is made up of (at present) 6 boards plus fiddle yard around the back. The boards are a softwood frame and a thin ply support for the 60mm foam topping. The track is mounted directly on the foam. Each board has built in sets of legs, giving a working height of +/-90mm (36").

L9 Stanfording

O Gauge Finescale

Stanfording is an Irish Heritage Railway (32mm finescale) set sometime within the last 30 - 40 years. The buildings, many drawn from the LMS NCC, are modelled from prototypes in Northern Ireland. Locomotives and stock are models from the Great Northern Railway of Ireland and LMS Northern Counties Committee. Points and somersault signals are operated with servos switched from a Modratec interlocking frame

L10 Newhurst

O Gauge Finescale

Newhurst is a 7mm finescale exhibition layout depicting a fictitious location on a secondary main line somewhere in Hampshire near the New Forest, the name deriving from New Forest and Lyndhurst. The through station is at the junction of a short branch to Bramble Quay, which is also fictitious. The layout is set circa 1961/62, featuring steam locos and some diesels, all appropriate to that period and location.

LII Stodden Hundreds

O Gauge Finescale

Stodden Hundreds Light Railway is set on the Bedfordshire/Cambridgeshire borders, in the 1930s. It serves local industries (brick works, gasworks and a brewery). There's a varied selection of industrial locomotives and second hand coaches. Available in various lengths between 9ft and 34ft. The large version includes an engine shed and works and interchange to the LNER.

L12 Newport Test Track

This is a two-track oval operated in DCC or DC. There are an additional two roads for stabling trains prior to running. Trackwork is Peco. This is the 2nd test track, again visitors are invited to bring along stock they wish to run.

L13 Bwthyn Y Rhosod

Bwthyn Y Rhosod, (Rose Cottage) is a shunting layout based on a leafy goods yard. It features a working crane to unload wagons and RC Lorries to then take goods away through operating crossing and yard gates. The layout is 14 x 2ft and is operated from the front, the locomotive stock is radio controlled. The location is left open so that I can run both SR and LNER locos.

The owner will also be demonstrating how he uses radio control to operate the layout.



L15 Mill Bank Alley

O Gauge Finescale

This layout is based on a fictitious branch line around Halifax in the 70s. The line sees freight traffic to the coal yard and chocolate/ bricks are loaded and unloaded and see their way to other sites around the country.

The layout sees use of both ready built and scratch built buildings with many bits and pieces from many manufactures to give the scenic effect. Locomotives are diesel sound fitted with the wagons both kit built and ready to run. The track work is C&L and hand built points with fitted fishplates and the use of tortoise slow action point motors to give a more realistic operation.

I used Woodland Scenics OO gauge ballast as I felt it gave a better look as most yards the ballast was crushed and compacted and filled in with spillages. The layout is operated with a NCE powercab controller (most locomotives take only 0.5A running)

I have used static grass to give the realistic effect and detail bits from Woodland Scenics and Green Scene. The vehicles on the layout have been toned down and weathered to give a more prototypical look.



O Gauge Finescale

Having lived a stone's throw from Healey Mills Yard I have always had the idea of modelling a diesel depot. The yard and its depot had been closed for quite a while before the demolition team moved in to raze the office buildings and loco shed to the ground. I managed to get some photos before it went and also found quite a few shots of the inside of the shed on the internet.

When my dad suggested we build a new layout I thought 'How about a small diesel depot?' We used the Healey Mills shed as a starting point albeit a shortened version. Our chosen track plan was drawn using AutoCAD with point templates imported from Templot. The locomotive shed is based on the diesel shed at Healey Mills (now demolished), but shortened to house one loco length instead of two. It is a plywood shell with Plastikard base layer covered with brick or corrugated embossed Plastikard. The interior has the steel building columns and sheeting rails showing, along with the roof trusses. There are also two inspection pits. Loco stock is mainly RTR Heljan and Dapol with a couple of JLTRT kits. Liveries are mainly correct for around 1967/8.
